SUMMER WORSHIP times are: 8 am and 9:30 am starting **June 11th**.

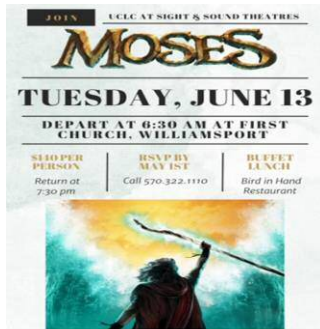
