# August 2023 Experiencing Summer J.O.Y.

The official mission statement of St. Luke Church is "Experience the J.O.Y.: Come and worship, Go and Serve". Experiencing the "J.O.Y." means that  $\underline{\mathbf{J}}$  esus is at the center of your life, impacting your relationship with  $\underline{\mathbf{O}}$  there and the world around you, and bringing personal growth to  $\underline{\mathbf{Y}}$  ou as a disciple of Christ.

As I look ahead to the month of August, it occurs to me that we are most definitely not taking the summer off from this mission.

Keeping Jesus at the center: A key (but not the only) way to keep Jesus at the center of our lives is to maintain a healthy worship life. Summer is a great time for relaxation, but that's all the more reason to be more intentional about worship, whether that be on Sunday morning or through devotional times throughout the day. I plan on holding sessions at New Trail Brewing at 6 p.m. on July 30, and August 13 and 27. I have found these times to be a wonderful way not only for us to get to know each other better but to explore real life topics from a disciple's perspective.
