

ANNUAL FALL HYMN SING OCTOBER 5, 2025 LUTHERAN CHURCH IN MUNCY



Pastor Jeff will be leading the upcoming Annual Fall Hymn Sing at Old Immanuel Lutheran Church, 2633 Lime Bluff Road, Muncy. The service will take place on Sunday, October 5, 2025, at 2:30pm. Relying on his dual denominational background, Pastor Jeff will be exploring the musical connection between the Lutheran and Methodist traditions, with several hymns by the prolific Methodist hymn writer Charles Wesley and prominent Lutheran hymn writers, including Martin himself. Each hymn on the program appears in both the Lutheran Book


of Worship and the United Methodist Hymnal. Our own Rebecca Ciabattari will provide acompaniment on the church's antique pump organ.

Old Immanuel is considered to be the mother church of Lutheranism in Lycoming County. Founded in 1791, Old Immanuel housed a Lutheran congregation in four different structures until closing in 1920.

In those nearly 130 years, Old Immanuel gave rise to 19 other Lutheran congregations, some having also closed but others remain. Those include Trinity and Mount Zion, Hughesville; St. Andrew, Muncy; St. James, Muncy; Messiah, Clarkstown; St. John's, Gordner's Grove; St. John's (Brick), Montgomery; and Bethany, Montoursville.

The public is invited to attend this service as well as to tour the historic church. Light refreshments will be served on the church lawn after the service. Please note that the church does not have running water or electricity, and is not fully handicap accessible. 
